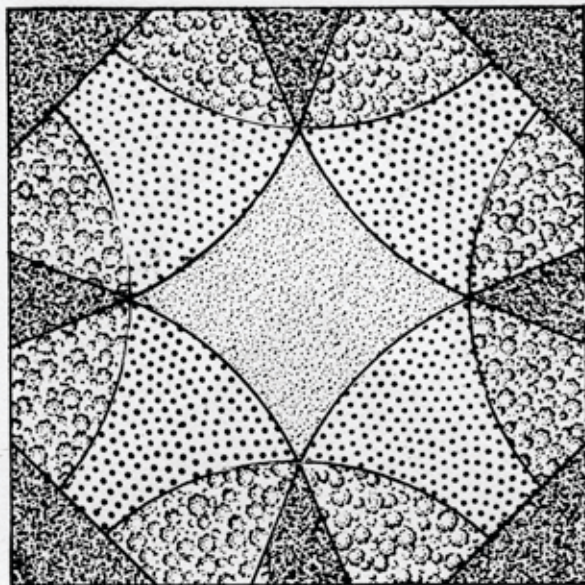


75. Morning Glory

A	1 Yellow	42
B	4 Light Blue	168
C	8 Medium Blue	336
D	4 Dark Blue	168
E	4 Dark Blue	168

PER QUILT:

(Fabrics can be all print, all plain or a combination of both. This also makes a good scrap quilt if you repeat the same color for Parts D and E throughout.)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Yellow—1 3/4 yards

Medium Blue—3 1/4 yards

Light Blue—3 1/4 yards

Dark Blue—2 1/4 yards

This is a fairly new pattern dating from the turn of the century. It is complex and difficult to piece though, so the novice is advised to pass it by for a while.

Pattern p. 149 shows the pieces in their proper order. Part A shows 1/4 of the center so a full-sized template must be made first. Fold a piece of paper into quarters and lay the Part A pattern with the dash lines along the folds. Using it, draw the curved line. Cut on the curve.

A border can be added if desired.
